Fundamental Analysis

AON stock has risen 28.79% over the past year, reaching \$409.12 in the last session, near its 52-week high. Revenue growth of 17.36% is strong compared to its 3-year average of 8.96%, but earnings growth of just 3.51% and a free cash flow decline of -14.62% indicate profitability and liquidity challenges. Margins have weakened, with net profit at 16.91% compared to 18.94% historically. Financial leverage at 8.00x is concerning, posing risks in a high-interest environment. However, ROE remains solid at 44.44%, reflecting efficient shareholder equity utilization. A P/E of 32.76x and P/S of 5.55x suggest possible overvaluation. In conclusion, while AON has demonstrated impressive revenue growth and maintains strong ROE, the company faces significant challenges, including modest earnings growth, declining free cash flow, and financial leverage concerns. Investors should remain cautious, as the current valuation may not be sustainable unless profitability improves. Overall, AON's stock presents a complex picture, balancing growth potential against underlying risks.
